Access

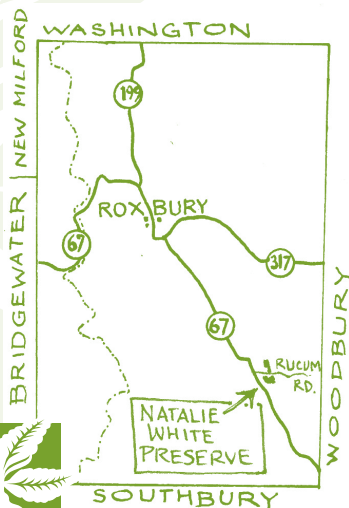

Steps and boardwalk

The trail heads north across an open field, then downhill toward a wooded area with a boardwalk. It then crosses a stone wall and to the hilltop and Natalie White Memorial sculpture, which was created by Natalie's father, sculptor Robert White. A lovely spot for a quiet picnic, the hilltop affords distant views of the rolling hills and farmlands of Roxbury and beyond.
